Creditable service includes service where an employee is not in a "covered" position, that is, when not subject to retirement deductions, such as service under a temporary appointment. (See Chapter 10, Coverage, and 12, Special Coverage Rules, to determine whether an employee is "covered."). CSRS FERS - U.S. Office of Personnel Management The payroll office must report the withholdings and contributions for employee life and health insurance premiums, and retirement coverage to OPM no later than the date the payroll is paid. (See section 80A1.1-2, paragraph B, for information on reporting periods.)

FERS Information - U.S. Office of Personnel Management FERS is a retirement plan that provides benefits from three different sources: a Basic Benefit Plan, Social Security and the Thrift Savings Plan (TSP). Two of the three parts of FERS (Social Security and the TSP) can go with you to your next job if you leave the Federal Government before retirement.. The CSRS subchapter gives complete information about the Chapter subject and how it pertains to CSRS.. FERS The Federal Employees Retirement Sys tem, or FERS, became effective January 1, 1987. Almost all new employees hired after December 31, 1983, are automatically covered by FERS. Certain other Federal employees not covered by FERS have the option to transfer into the plan.
