Configuring the network - Gentoo Wiki For most users, there are only two settings needed to connect, the ESSID (aka wireless network name) and, optionally, the WEP key. First, ensure the interface is active: `root # ip link set dev wlp9s0 up`. To connect to an open network with the name GentooNode: `root # iw dev wlp9s0 connect -w GentooNode`.

Configuring the system - Gentoo Wiki systemd. To set the system hostname for a system currently running systemd, the `hostnamectl` utility may be used. During the installation process however, `systemd-firstboot` command must be used instead (see later on in handbook). For setting the hostname to "tux", one would run: `root # hostnamectl hostname tux`. The official Gentoo boot media provides support for Logical Volume Manager (LVM).LVM can combine physical volumes such as partitions or disks into volume groups.Volume groups are more flexible than partitions and can be used to define RAID groups or caches on fast SSDs for slow HDs.
